

Filler

Sand filler should be of manufactured, washed and dried, with no moisture. Grit sizes from 50 to 70 paper bag aggregate. * Product will bond damaged slabs together and may stop movement. Not intended for use where substrate movement is required.

Application

Clean the area of debris and contaminants that would act to disbond product such as oils, loose materials, dirt, rubber etc. Expose clean rough concrete by using a grinder with a twisted wire wheel. Make sure the area is dry.

Where the crack is deep

- Apply product to the bottom of the crack and work up in layers.
- First apply product, then add sand into the product, then more product & sand.
- Repeat the steps in layers until reaching the finished grade.

Moisture

Rapid Restore is sensitive to moisture before the two parts (A & B) are mixed, after they are mixed and until the product sets.
